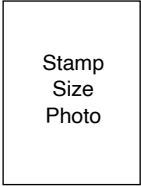

## Rules & Regulations

1. The students are supposed to reach the school 5 minutes before the school starts. Attendance will be taken before the Assembly.
2. Pupils must be courteous and respectful to everyone.
3. Speaking in English is obligatory within the school premises.
4. Students should maintain discipline and observe good manners.
5. Criticism of the teacher or school in the presence of a child should be avoided.
6. Every child should take proper care of the school property. Damages even by accident should be reported at once to the Class Teacher/Principal & damage cost will be realized by the student.
7. Every student should take care of the private property. Money should not be lent or borrowed. The school is not responsible for the goods lost.
8. Students suffering from any contagious disease will not be allowed to continue classes until he/she recovers from it and submits the fitness certificate from a doctor.
9. Bicycles must be properly locked and kept in the cycle stand.
10. Every student should carry his/her school diary to school every day.
11. The warning bell before a class or assembly is a signal for all to go to the assembly or to their respective class-rooms. This should be done in silence. Changing of classrooms during periods should be done in silence and in an orderly manner.
12. Students should be very neatly dressed. The school uniform should be worn on all working days. No relaxation is acceptable in this regard. General turn out of student will be checked during assembly or at any time during their stay in the school by the staff and defaulters will be punished.
13. The students should bring tiffin, spoon, napkin and handkerchief daily.
14. Students will not be permitted to leave the school during the school hours without the written permission.
15. Students should attend all the festivals and functions celebrated in the school.
16. Parents should co-operate with the school in its attempt to help their children progress, paying attention to their punctuality, regularity and discipline. They should take interest in their child's studies & extracurricular activities.

17. Taking leave during working days is strongly discouraged. Parents are responsible to make up for the loss of the studies in case of leave taken. The school will expect these students to be at par with the class in every way and that must be ensured by the parents only.
18. Valuable articles like gold/diamond jewelry are not permitted inside the school premises. If such instances are repeated, then the child may be asked to leave the school.

## **GUIDELINES TO PARENTS / GUARDIANS**

Shree Bharath Vidhyaashram is a progressive and a growing institution. In order to realize the highest ideals of education, to nurture the sterling qualities of an all rounded personality and to inculcate healthy competition while maintaining individual identities under perfect care without constraining inherent qualities. We at SBV need your fullest co-operation with all your resources (Physical, Social and Economical) in this to help us in achieving our goal.

1. Any communication made by the Parent/Guardian should be addressed to the Principal through the Class Teacher and all correspondence from the school to the Parents will be made by the Principal.
2. Parents are expected to dress in a dignified manner while coming to the school.
3. Students are advised not to bring valuable articles .School shall not undertake any responsibility for the loss.
4. Parents are required to co-operate with the school in its attempt to help their children progress by paying attention to punctuality and discipline and take interest in their child's work. They should check the almanac everyday and note the homework and other instructions given. They are advised to check the bags of their wards to see if any circular/notice/ invitation etc has been issued.
5. All students are expected to join the school on the notified date at the beginning of the term.
6. It is compulsory for the student to complete 90% of the attendance in the year to make him/her eligible to appear for the final examination.
7. Once the name is struck off from the roll, re-admission can be done only with the permission of the Principal.
8. Parents must first consult the school calendar, and other circulars, before making enquiries on the phone.
9. Parents must provide the school with correct mobile numbers and also inform about the changes (if any) so that SMS containing important messages like attendance, marks, etc. can be sent to them.

10. Parents are requested to inform the school if there is any change in their address and telephone numbers.
11. Children when sick should not be sent to school to attend tests/classes.
12. Parents are requested not to enter the classroom to see their children or teachers during school hours without the prior permission of the Principal.
13. Parents should ensure that their wards prepare their lessons well and do their homework regularly.
14. Parents should make sure that for any absence from the school, written intimation is sent to the class teacher.

## Balanced Diet for Kids

### Healthy Eating Habits for Kids

During the early years, children learn what, when, and how much to eat based on the family culture, attitudes, beliefs and practices around food and eating.

By teaching your children healthy eating habits and modeling these behaviors in yourself, you can help your children maintain healthy growth. Also, the eating habits your children pick up when they are young, will help them maintain a healthy lifestyle when they are adults.

It's important for parents to support children to develop healthy food choices by providing healthy choices as the normal choice and being positive role models for healthy eating.

Developing healthy eating habits in their children include:

- | Guide your family's choices rather than dictate foods. Make a wide variety of healthy foods available in the house. This practice will help your children learn how to make healthy food choices. Avoid bottle soda and juice, and go for fresh juice. Serve water with meals.
- | Encourage your children to eat slowly. A child can detect hunger and fullness better when they eat slowly. Before offering a second helping or serving, ask your child to wait a few minutes to see if they are still hungry. This will give the brain, time to register fullness.
- | Eat meals together as a family as often as possible. Try to make mealtimes pleasant with conversation and sharing, not a time for scolding or arguing. If mealtimes are unpleasant, children may try to eat faster to leave the table as soon as possible.
- | Plan for snacks. Continuous snacking may lead to overeating, but snacks that are planned at specific times during the day can be part of a nutritious diet, without spoiling a child's appetite at meal times. You should make snacks as nutritious as possible, without depriving your children of occasional chips or cookies, especially at parties or other social events.
- | Discourage eating meals or snacks while watching TV. Try to eat only in designated areas of your home, such as the dining room or kitchen. Eating in front of the TV may make it difficult to pay attention to feelings of fullness, and may lead to overeating.
- | Encourage your children to drink more water. Over consumption of sweetened drinks and sodas has been linked to increased rates of obesity in children.
- | Find out more about their school lunch program, or pack their lunch to include a variety of foods. Also, select healthier items when dining at restaurants.

## TO BE HALF & HEALTHY : A BALANCED DIET FOR A DAY

The Choose My Plate icon is a guideline to help you and your child eat a healthy diet. My Plate icon can help you and your child eat a variety of foods while encouraging the right amount of calories and fat. The My Plate icon is divided into five food group categories, emphasizing the nutritional intake of the following:

- **Grains.** Foods that are made from wheat, rice, oats, cornmeal, barley, or another cereal grain are grain products. Examples include whole wheat, brown rice, and oatmeal.
- **Vegetables.** Vary your vegetables. Choose a variety of colorful vegetables, including dark green, red, and orange vegetables, legumes (peas and beans), and starchy vegetables.
- **Fruits.** Any fruit or 100 percent fruit juice counts as part of the fruit group. Fruits may be fresh, canned, frozen, or dried, and may be whole, cut up, or pureed.
- **Dairy.** Milk products and many foods made from milk are considered part of this food group. Focus on fat-free or low-fat products, as well as those that are high in calcium.
- **Protein.** Go lean on protein. Choose low-fat or lean meats and poultry. Vary your protein routine—choose more fish, nuts, seeds, peas, and beans.

Oils are not a food group, yet some, such as nut oils, contain essential nutrients and can be included in the diet. Animal fats are solid fats and should be avoided.

Exercise and everyday physical activity should also be included with a healthy dietary plan.

## SAVE WATER

**10 easy, everyday tips for how parents, can teach their kids to lessen their carbon footprint.**

**Conserve water:** When brushing teeth, turn off the water. Teach children about water-saver gardening through plant selection. “My kids are really focused on water conservation.

**Flick the switch:** Turn off the light when you leave the room.

**Close the door:** Keep doors to the outside closed so you won’t let air conditioning or heat escape.

**Garden:** Grow broccoli, lettuce, tomatoes, herbs and much more in their backyard. “Day to day, (children) will learn that you can grow your own foods and it tastes much better and you don’t put pesticides on it,” she says.

**Avoid plastic bags in lunchboxes:** Use recyclable containers when packing lunchboxes, with cloth napkins. Kindly don’t send them to school with Ziplocs As for the napkins, “You can get some really pretty designs and enjoy some beauty in your lunchbox instead of a white paper napkin that you’re just going to throw away.”

**Recycle:** Have kids put old worksheets in the paper bin, yogurt containers in the plastic bin. Recycling may seem an obvious habit but “there are so many communities that still don’t.” Parents can “complete the circle” by buying products made with recycled ingredients such as paper.

**Reuse:** Clean out jam or jelly jars and reuse them as drinking glasses — they’re the perfect size for little hands, and incorporate empty paper towel rolls into your youngster’s next art project.

**Compost:** Put leftover apple cores, banana peels and any other of nature’s wrappers in a compost bin, where they eventually will break down and turn into fertilizer.

**Walk or bike:** Instead of using gasoline to drive, walk or take your bicycle to school, to friends’ houses or to the store.

Give “**experience**” **gifts:** Instead of giving toys that will break or that kids will quickly tire of, take them to some orphanage and distribute sweets or lunch for them.

## Good Manners

Courtesy, Politeness and Good Manners, means kind and thoughtful consideration for others. Good Manners helps child to be noticed for all the right reasons.

Your child's rudeness is not always intentional. Sometimes kids do not realize they are wrong. And in the hustle and bustle of daily life, busy moms and dads don't always have the time to focus on etiquette or manners.

Below are the virtues, habits that will help your child to become courteous. As to Themselves

- | Be honest, truthful, and pure in thoughts.
- | Keep out of bad company.
- | Keep your face and hands clean, and your clothes and boots brushed and neat.
- | Be Polite.

At Home

- | Help your Parents as much as you can, and do your best to please them.
- | Be kind and affectionate to your brothers and sisters.
- | Do not be selfish, share all your good things.

At School

- | Be respectful to your Teachers, and help them as much as you can
- | Observe the school rules. Do not "Copy," nor cheat in any way
- | Do not cut the desks, not write in the reading books etc.
- | Never let another be punished for your mistake; this is cowardly and mean.
- | Do not tear pages from books.

At Play

- | Do not cheat at games. Do not bully other children.
- | Be pleasant and not Quarrelsome.
- | Do not jeer at your schoolmates, or call them by names.

In The Street

- | Greet elders, teachers, and acquaintances when you meet them.
- | Do not push nor run against people. Do not chalk on doors, windows and walls.

- | Do not throw stones, nor destroy public property.
- | Do not make slides on the pavement, nor throw orange peel and banana skins there: dangerous accidents often result from these practices.
- | Do not make fun of others, but be polite to them.

### At Table

- | Always wash your hands and face before coming to the table.
- | Look after other people: do not help yourself only. Do not be greedy.
- | Do not speak nor drink with food in your mouth.
- | Turn your head away from the table and put your hand or handkerchief before your mouth when you sneeze or cough.
- | Do not make fun of old nor crippled people, but be particularly polite to them, as well as the strangers and foreigners.

### Everywhere

- | Remember to say "Please" or "Thank You"; "Yes, Sir" or "Yes Ma'am"; "No, Sir" or "No, Ma'am."
- | Before entering a room it is often courteous to knock at the door. Do not forget to close the door quietly after you enter/step out.
- | Always show attention to older people and strangers by opening the door for them, bringing what they require (hat, chair, etc.), giving up your seat to them.
- | Never interrupt when a person is speaking.
- | Be punctual. Be tidy.
